The Board of Directors held several special meetings in March & April to discuss recent issues. Minutes from these meetings have been posted to the BOD Minutes screen which is accessed from the MANAGEMENT drop-down menu. Residents must sign-on with their unique USER NAME and PASSWORD to access BOD Minutes.

The Edgewater City Council continues to hold monthly meetings although attendance is restricted. A summary of recent council meetings appears in the attachment box at the bottom of the Civic Awareness screen.

CHRISTIE BEU-LET'S DANCE! - FRIDAY MAY 29TH 7:00 P.M - 10:00 P.M.

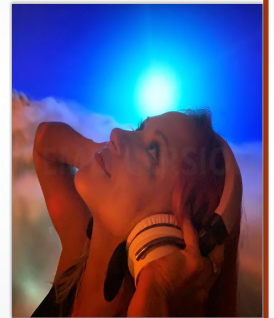
