The E/L Civic Awareness Committee has scheduled a "Meet the Candidates" night to allow candidates for Council Districts 2 & 4 to come to the Landing to discuss issues related to the upcoming November vote. This presentation will take place in the E/L Club House on October 19th starting at 6:30PM.

On November 8th E/L residents who are registered to vote in Edgewater elections will be able to vote for council members for District 2 and District 4. In addition, Edgewater voters will be asked to vote on six amendments to the City Charter. This presentation is intended to help voters make an informed choice.

The Civic Awareness Committee is asking residents to submit suggested questions ahead of time, so that the committee can review them to eliminate duplicates or questions not related to city issues. It is the committee's hope that this format will make better use of the allotted time.

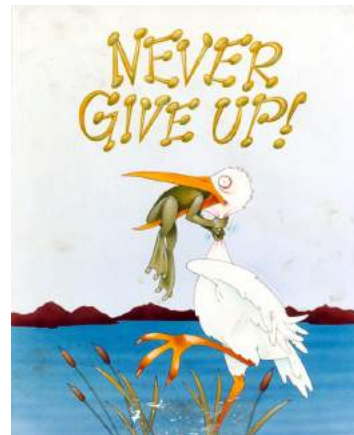

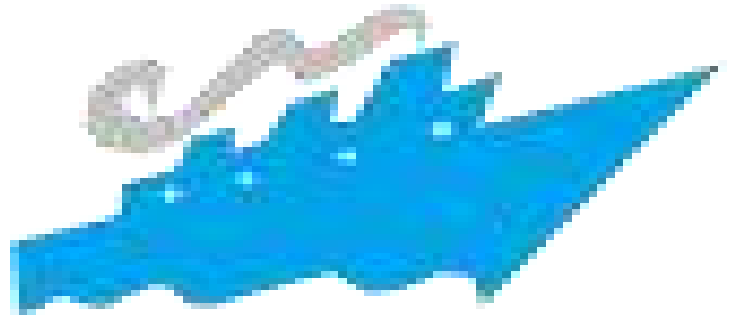
